Volunteer Drivers Are Needed to Transport Veterans to and from their VA Medical Appointments

The Disabled American Veterans (DAV) Transportation Program needs volunteer drivers to provide Veterans round-trip service to the Syracuse VA Medical Center. Volunteer drivers are also needed to provide transportation to and from VA Outpatient Clinics located in Massena, Rome, Carthage, Oswego, Auburn, Cortland, Ithaca and Binghamton.

All VA-enrolled Veterans are eligible to receive this service at no charge.

“It is an essential Veterans program,” says Frank Caputo, DAV Transportation Coordinator, “Most Veterans who use this service would have no other way to reach their critical VA medical appointments. They rely on our volunteer drivers.”

To qualify, one must have a driver’s license and have a “clean” driving record. Drivers do not have to be a Veteran to provide these services.
