Oswego County VA Outpatient Clinic Has Moved to the City of Oswego

The new location for the Oswego VA Outpatient Clinic, with services being provided by CRAssociates, Inc. provides improved accessibility for Veteran patients living in Southern Jefferson County, Northern Oswego County, and northern Onondaga County. The facility, currently serving more than 1800 Veteran men and women, provides more space than the previous location in Volney.

There will be two exam rooms for each primary care provider, improved privacy for Behavioral Health services, dietary consultations with a registered dietitian five days per week, space for pharmacy consultation, and an enlarged conference room for group patient centered activities, and telemedicine.

The facility located at 437 State Route 104 East, next to LOWE'S, is approximately 10 minutes from Oswego Hospital, where agreements have been made to provide services, such as radiology and "stat" laboratory support. The new facility is located on a Centro Bus line, with bus service provided to the door. The Clinic opened its doors on June 1st.

CRAssociates is based in Newington, Virginia.

Syracuse VA Medical Center operates eight Community-Based Outpatient Clinics (CBOCs) across the 13-counties of Central New York. Their locations include Massena, Watertown, Oswego, Rome, Auburn, Cortland, Ithaca, & Binghamton.
