Syracuse, NY- On Saturday, February 27, 2016, the Syracuse VA will participate in a VA-Nationwide Clinical Access Stand Down. A team of senior Medical Center clinical leaders and administrators will be on site to re-affirm that processes are in place to ensure that Veterans are being seen in the most appropriate time frame and by the proper health care provider.

The event is a nationwide effort being undertaken by the Veterans Health Administration at VA medical centers across the nation focusing efforts to provide timely patient care and foster a culture of continuous improvement in the VA's health care system.
